



Case study

Scottish Council – Learning Campus



Background:

This Scottish Council embarked on an ambitious project to create a Learning Campus, a state-of-the-art facility merging several educational institutions.

This modern, low-carbon campus aimed to provide an exceptional learning environment for pupils, students, and staff.

Challenge:

The new campus had a strict opening date, leaving a limited timeframe for IT commissioning. XMA was tasked with configuring a large volume of devices and delivering them to the campus within tight deadlines. This included:

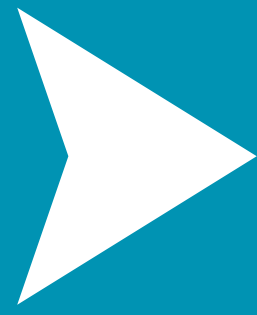
- **SCCM Imaging and Asset Tagging:** Preparing over 1200 PCs, laptops, iPads, iMacs and Chromebooks with the necessary software and asset tracking.
- **Delivery and Deployment:** Coordinating the delivery and deployment of devices according to the council's schedule, including unboxing and setup. Weekly communications with Fife Council team working on the DLC Project to manage last minute changes.
- **Time Constraints:** Meeting the challenging deadlines associated with the campus opening date, with equipment arriving in late April and deployment commencing in early July.



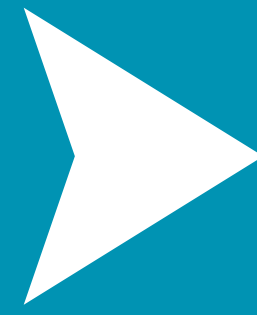
Solution:
